The Co-Curricular Activities give our young learners ample opportunities to exhibit their talents and encourages a culture of collaboration as well as collaboration.

This year too, there were an ensemble of activities planned in both online and offline mode.

Activity 1:

Poster and slogan making on Interpersonal relationship post COVID 19

Students were asked to make a Poster and write a slogan on the topic – Interpersonal Relationships post Covid. They were instructed to keep the required material and ideas ready before the period and do it only during the CCA period in front of the teacher. The class teacher was the judge and the parameters like: Neatness, Creativity and Presentation were declared beforehand, so that the children could prepare accordingly. We were pleasantly surprised to see their innovative ideas and creativity.

Activity 2

Intraclass Story telling Competition: Follow your Passion.

We all know, that our young children have multifaceted passions and goals. To encourage that zeal in them, the theme was chosen. In this activity, they not only could write about their passion, but also got a platform to speak their heart out in their own words. This was the level I where children had to compete within their class, followed by an Inter class coemption. The parameters were: -- Originality, Creativity, Props, Body language and Presentation.

It was indeed inspiring to listen to the various conventional and non-conventional passions that these young minds have.

Activity 3

Inter class Story telling competition

Winners of intraclass story telling competition participated in this level and the topic was – **World of your Dreams**. It was judged by the class teachers of the participating grades and the parameters were: Originality & Creativity, Body language, Use of Props and timing. The other children were given an opportunity to be present as audience to listen to their classmates.

Activity 4

Debate: There were two different topics assigned to the following classes.

Grade VI and VII: **“Technology is a bliss.”**

Grade VIII and IX: **“Advertisements are confusing the customers ”**

Students of the class were divided into 2 groups. It was also ensured that both the groups had equal expertise. They were given time to prepare for the debate. One group choose to speak for the topic and other group was against it. All the students took part in this. and one team was declared the winner on the basis of following parameters - Relevance, Rebuttal and confidence. It was a treat for us to see their confidence and potential.

Activity 5

Hindi Story competition

We all understand the importance of Hindi language. In order to encourage the usage of this language and celebrate the richness of the official language of our Nation, we had organised a story telling competition in Hindi. The children were judged on the parameters of: Pronunciation, clarity, confidence and presentation.

Activity 6

National Youth Day

National Youth Day, also known as **Vivekananda Jayanti**, is celebrated on 12 January every year to commemorate the birth day of Swami Vivekanand. Students celebrated National Youth Day by reciting the Poems composed by Swami Vivekananda. They were judged by the parameters of Presentation, Voice modulation and confidence.

Activity 7

Public speaking: Extempore

Communication and leadership are very important aspects of the 21st century skills. In order to boost their communication skills an extempore public speaking competition was held.

Activity 8

Post Card Writing

This was a unique programme initiated by CBSE. Students were asked to write a Post card to the Prime Minister of India on the following topics – Unsung heroes of freedom struggle/ My vision for India 2047. The letters were posted to the honourable Prime Minister.

Activity 9

Matrabhasha Diwas

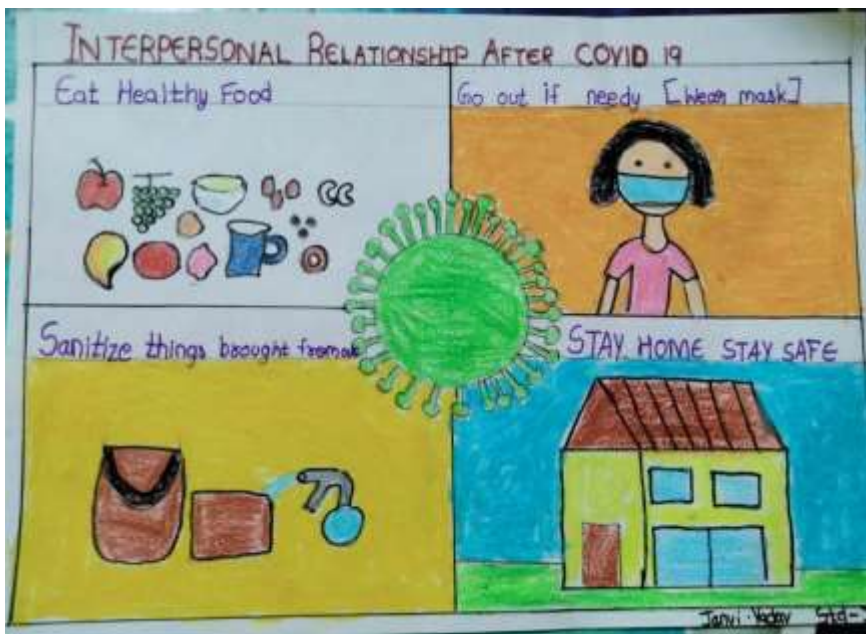
