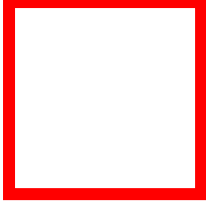

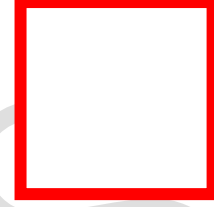

## Admission Policy

Admission will be on a first come first serve basis. However all things being equal the student who resides closer to the school will be given preference.

First preference will be given to siblings of children studying in our school next in line will be children of the employees of D Y Patil Group. Then consideration will be given to other admissions.

- New admissions are subject to vacancies. No correspondence will be entertained as regards to admissions.
- The management reserves the right to admit or retain a pupil in the school.
- New pupils are admitted on payment of the admission fee. The admission fee is nonrefundable, under any circumstances.
- The school fees will be charged from the month of April irrespective of the month of admission.
- The age criteria will be as follows - :

## Withdrawal

- One calendar week's notice is required to be given for the withdrawal of the student before the payment schedule else fees for the month will be charged.
- School leaving certificate will not be issued until all the school dues have been paid in full.

## Rules for issue of Leaving Certificate

Parents are requested to note the following:

- TC application form is attached to calendar.
- The process will take 7 working days.
- The admission fee receipt to be produced while claiming the Caution Money deposit.
- Caution Money will be refunded against original receipts only.

## Note to Parents

- Parents are a fundamental part of the school and the school expects them to co-operate in enforcing all the guidelines that will benefit the child and assist in the smooth functioning of the school.
- The calendar aims at establishing an individual link among teachers, students and parents. It intends to serve as a means of communication between parents and the school.
- The calendar can be used for convenient, day to day correspondence (related to academics and conduct) between parents and the school staff. Apart from this the other matters should be discussed with the Principal.
- Dnyanshanti School lays emphasis on punctuality, regularity, neat and clean school uniform and obedience to study and work assignments. Absenteeism from school without a proper reason is discouraged. Absenteeism has an adverse impact on the child's academic and overall progress.
- Parents must ensure that their wards sleep for a minimum of seven hours every night. We are advocates of early to bed and early to rise makes Jack healthy, wealthy and wise.
- We recommend that students should have at least an hour of physical activity every day.
- Parents to ensure that students attend school in neat clean and complete uniform.
- Students must reach school five minutes before the bell for the assembly.
- Parents must ensure that students are provided with nutritious and adequate food daily.
- Parents must monitor the daily activities and overall performance of their child; regularly, check the almanac and their bags occasionally. Parents are advised to spend quality time with their children to instill confidence and motivation.
- Dnyanshanti School will always insist on English as a mode of communication. Parents must work on giving opportunities to their wards to converse in English at home.
- Parents are expected to encourage their child in balanced participation in academics, co-curricular activities as well as sports.
- Parents should know that the students are not allowed to wear any ornaments or bring any valuable articles (I-Pods, Calculators, Mobiles etc.) to the school. Bringing money to the school is not allowed. Students are not allowed to bring any weapons or sharp instruments. Violation may result in suspension or levying of heavy fine. Items once confiscated will not be returned under any circumstances. Parents will not be entertained on these issues.
- Criticism of the teacher or the institution in the presence of your children should be scrupulously avoided because it may cause loss of respect to the teacher as well as the School and this may further retard your ward's progress.

**It is the duty of a DYPDSS Student to:**

- understand the school's principles and make every effort to support its vision through his/her behaviour and deeds.
- comply with all school rules and regulations and maintain decorum in and outside the school premises.
- ensure respect and a cordial relation with the faculty, housekeeping personnel, transport staff and other fellow students.
- maintain positivity in thought and language while interacting with others as well as with yourself.
- resolve conflicts peacefully and in a situation of emergency or crisis behave calmly.
- practise honesty in daily behaviour as well as all forms of assessments.
- indulge only in healthy practices and refrain from the use of abusive language that is harmful to himself / herself and others.
- help to keep the school premises clean.
- adopt a sense of belongingness to the school premises in order to look after school property with care.
- conduct himself / herself with dignity and respect for the community at large.
- **Guidelines for parents**
- Students must ensure that they bring the calendar to school every day.
- Students must maintain regular and punctual attendance to school, classes, school events and activities.
- Students must report to school on time. After 2 late warnings the student will not be allowed to attend classes.
- If a student misses the school bus the parent must drop the child to school by 7:55 am. The child should not be sent in any other Primary Bus to school.
- Silence must be observed in the corridors and the stairways. The students must move in a disciplined manner.
- Students are not allowed to carry mobiles or electronic gadgets to school and while travelling in the school bus.
- Students are to refrain from bringing any kind of sharp objects to school.
- Using abusive languages, bullying and hurting other students, causing damage to school property will lead to disciplinary action.
- Students found to be using unfair or dishonest means during assessments will be penalized.
- Any kind of tattoos or jewelry is not allowed to school.
- Students may wear coloured clothes to school on the occasion of birthdays. They may distribute chocolates (Cadbury/Nestle) to their classmates but no return gifts are permitted .
- Any kinds of gifts on any occasion to teachers is strictly prohibited.
- English should be the only language of communication in the school . Students must not use any other languages.



- In cases of emergency students can only be picked from school between 10:00 am to 11:00 am.
- In case of the child being unwell kindly refrain from sending your child to school. In case the child feels unwell in school you will receive a call from us and you will be expected to pick your child from school. You will need to carry the parent ID card for the purpose. School does have a trained nurse to attend to medical emergencies but no oral medication will be administered to the child.
- All students must focus on keeping the school flag high by his /her all round performance.
- The school management reserves the right to change the rules and regulations time to time for the betterment and the same shall be binding on all concerned.

## School Fees

1. Payment of fees is the responsibility of the parents. It should be paid in time. It must be paid as per the schedule given by the school.

2. Students will not be allowed to sit for assessments unless fees are cleared as per the schedule.

Our school uniform is an integral part of the school. It defines and identifies us as members of the same community.

Formal uniform to be worn on Wednesday.(Grade III to IX )

- All items of apparel must be clean and well pressed; footwear must be regularly polished.
- Girls should have their hair neatly combed and wear a black hair band. Long hair must be braided. Hair left loose should not cover the forehead or touch the collar. Only black hair clips may be used.
- Girls are not permitted to use colored ribbons, clips or slides, make-up, lipstick, nail paint fancy colorful earrings, wear golden/silver/diamond ornaments, friendship bands, threads, fancy and colourful frame for spectacles, fancy watches, fancy hair styles.
- Boys must have their hair cut short. Unconventional hair cuts or hair styles are not allowed.
- Nails should be neatly clipped and kept clean.
- Girls are not allowed to apply henna on their hands.
- Students are not allowed to wear fancy watches.

Students who do not comply with the regulations are liable to be penalized and sent back home .

### **Attendance**

- 1.It is compulsory for students to achieve 85% attendance in each term in order to be eligible to take the end of the term assessment.
2. Prior permission of the Principal is required for availing of leave more than 3 days for personal reasons.
3. All students are expected to attend school on the reopening day immediately following the vacations.
- 4.In case of absence the parent is expected to send a note in the calendar.
- 5.In case of long absence due to illness the student must produce doctor's fitness certificate permitting him/her to attend school.
6. Absence from school for merely social functions is strongly discouraged .

### **Library Rules**

The school library is open to all bonafide students of the school. At least one library period is provided in the weekly schedule for each class. This fosters among the pupils the habit of sound reading and acquiring knowledge.

Students have to observe the following rules:

- Students must carry a library card duly signed by the librarian.
- Students must maintain silence in the library.
- Books are to be taken care; any damage or loss of a book will be penalized based on its value.
- Students can borrow books on their own cards only.
- Reference books, journals and magazines to be handled within the school library and will not be issued to students.
- A fine of Rs 5 will be charged for a book which is not returned within 2 weeks.

## House System

To foster a sense of ownership and healthy competition as well as collaboration we have organized students from Grade III upwards into four Houses.
